## A Com Com

こむこむ

Next to Fukushima Station, features a range of activities for children including a planetarium, library, workshops, exhibition spaces, movies, and stage shows.



## B Ogura-tei

御倉邸

Fukushima City was a distribution center for the silk industry, and home to the first Bank of Japan branch in the Tohoku region. This residence was owned by the bank manager.



## C Fukushima Inari Shrine

福島稲荷神社

Founded in 987 by famed spiritualist Abe no Seimei. The current shrine was designed by Oe Shintaro who also designed Meiji Shrine in Tokyo.



## D Fukushima City Hall

福島市役所

Features an observation deck on the 9th floor with panoramic views of the surrounding city and mountains.



## E Fukushima Racecourse

福島競馬場

One of ten Japan Racing Association tracks in Japan. Race carnivals are held 3 times a year. Includes a wide range of activities including a central play area and rose garden.



## F Toho Minna no Bunka Center

とうほうみんなの文化センター

Regularly holds art exhibitions and concerts. The Prefectural Archives are located next door and exhibits historical documents related to the history of Fukushima Prefecture.



## G Mt. Shinobu

信夫山

With an elevation of 300m there are several observation decks with amazing city views. Haguro Shrine houses the largest 'waraji' straw sandal (12m, 2t) in Japan.



## H Fukushima Pref. Museum of Art

福島県立美術館

Displays national and international exhibitions. Its collection includes artwork by artists Andrew Wyeth and Ben Shahn, as well as Fukushima woodcut print artist Kiyoshi Saito.



## I MAX Fukushima

MAX ふくしま

A short walk from Fukushima Station East Exit, MAX Fukushima has a range of restaurants, gift shops, a 100-yen store, movie theatre, and more.



## J Corasse Fukushima

コラッセふくしま

The 1st floor souvenir gift shop has products from all over Fukushima Prefecture. The observation deck on the 12th floor has panoramic views of the city and western mountains.



## K Yuji Koseki Memorial Hall

古関裕而記念館

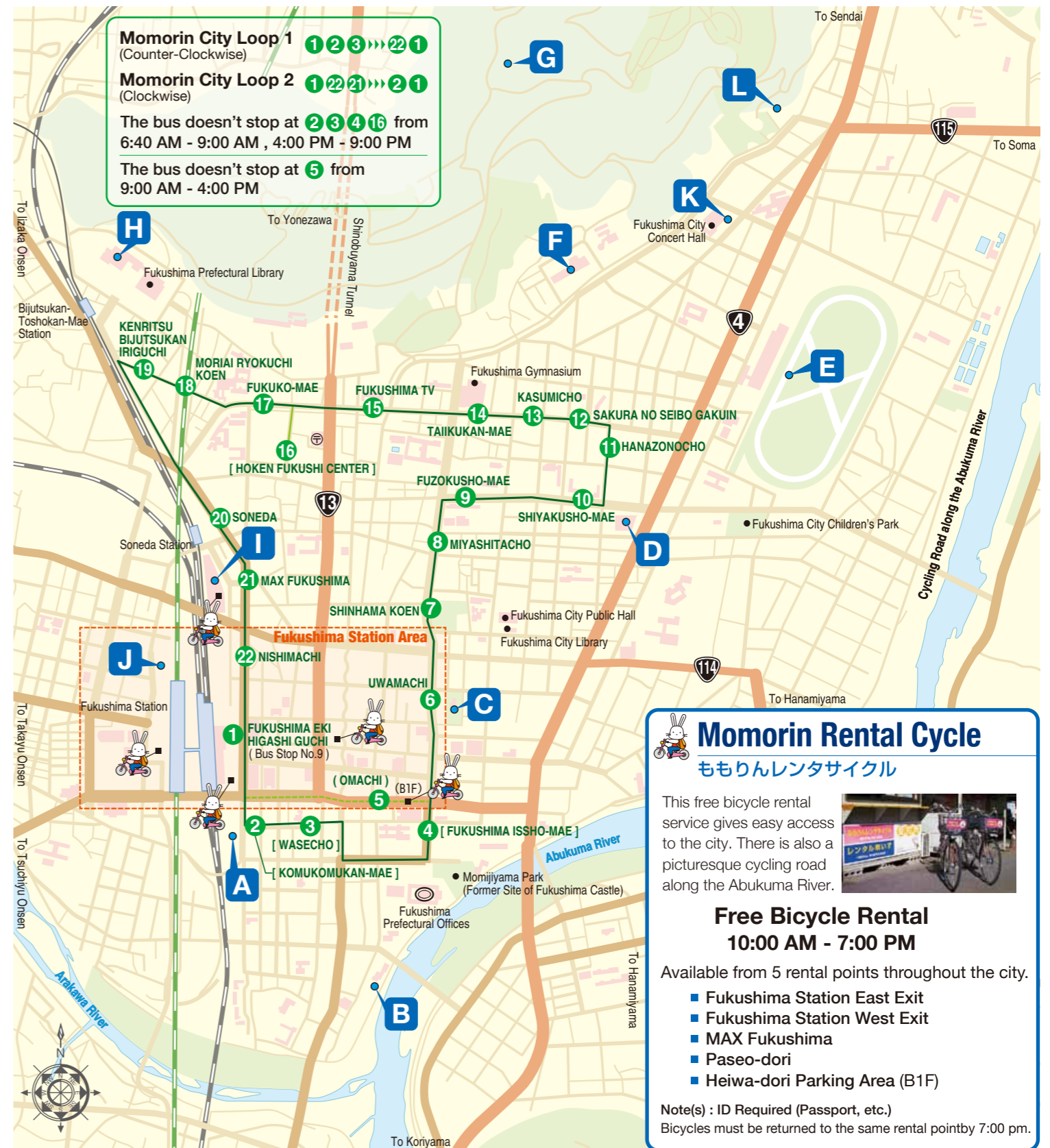
This museum commemorates renowned Fukushima born composer Yuji Koseki, and houses a collection of his records, music scores, and memorabilia.



## L Iwaya Kannon

岩谷観音

Situated on the south-east face of Mt. Shinobu, this collection of around 60 Buddhist carvings dates back over 800 years from the later Heian and Kamakura periods.



## Momorin Rental Cycle

ももりんレンタサイクル  
 This free bicycle rental service gives easy access to the city. There is also a picturesque cycling road along the Abukuma River.

## Momorin City Loop

Fare : 100 yen Buses every 20 mins.

Momorin City Loop 1 runs in a counter-clockwise loop around the city. Momorin City Loop 2 runs in a clockwise loop around the city.



- ### Using the bus:
1. Board the bus by the back door.
  2. Take a ticket from the ticket machine.
  3. Press the STOP button when you want to get off.
  4. Put your ticket and 100 yen into the fare collector when you get off the bus.
- Note : No change is given, please use the correct fare. Change is available from the change machine at the front of the bus.
